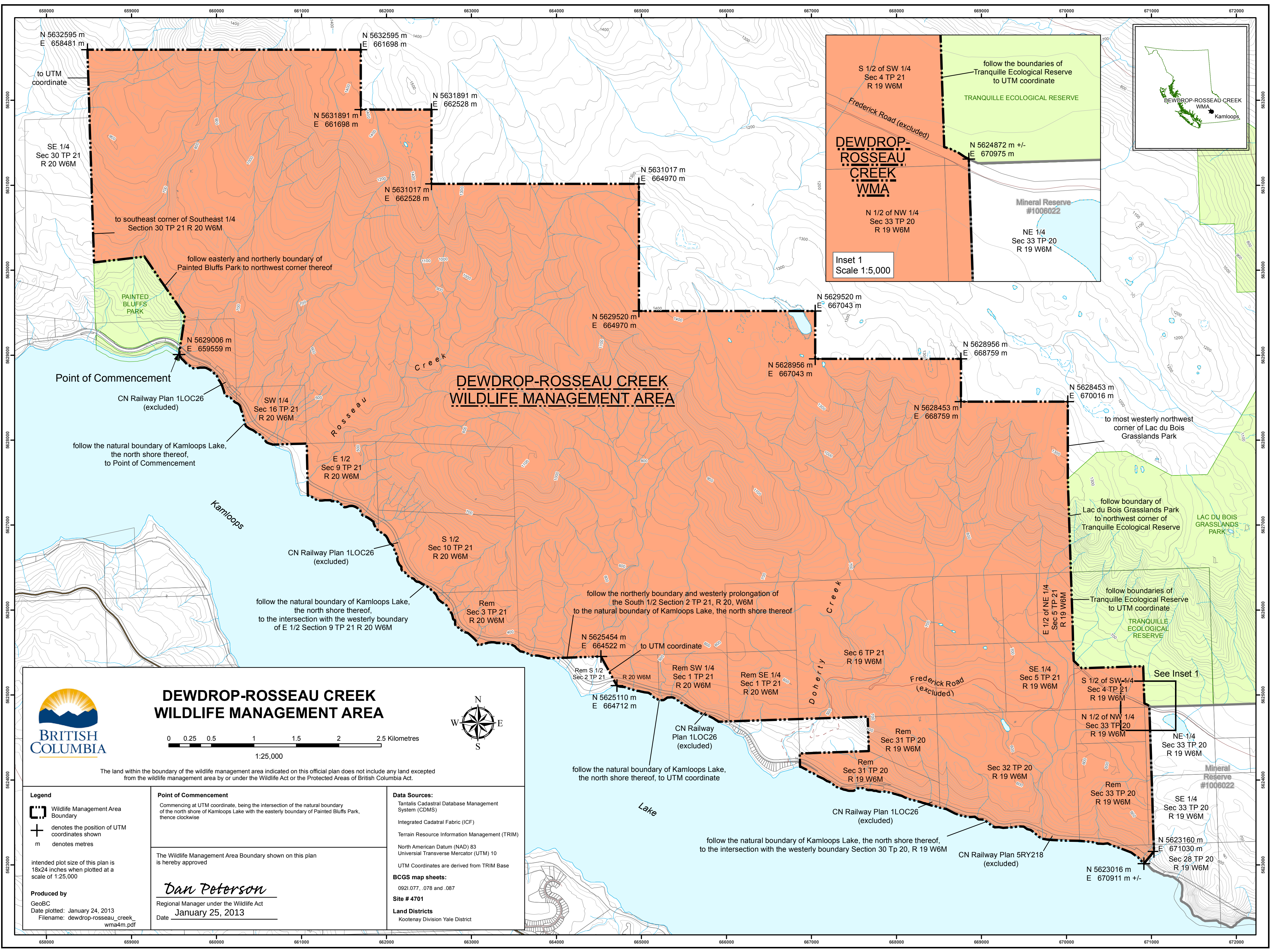
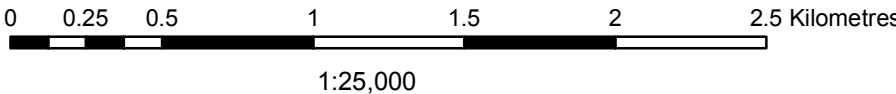




DEWDROP-ROSSEAU CREEK WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA
