Dear Mr. Morin:

I am sending this letter to notify you that the Province of British Columbia has chosen to designate an Aggregator of Addressing and GIS Data per the directive of the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission in the decision 2020-150, paragraph 22. The Province's decision identifies <u>GeoBC and Natural Resource Sector Data Services</u> (GeoBC), an agency of the Ministry of Water, Land and Resource Stewardship (WLRS) as the Aggregator of Addressing and GIS Data for the province of British Columbia. The designation of GeoBC in this critically important role confirms the long-standing work of this agency in managing and delivering spatial data to 911 service providers of the province.

GeoBC will provide TELUS, and Northwestel as appropriate, with all the required GIS data layers for British Columbia's implementation of Next-Generation 9-1-1 in accordance with the adopted standards.
