Order of the Regional Director

TO: Public Notice

DATE: 2023-06-26

WHEREAS:

- A. Kiskatinaw Provincial Park ("the Park") which is located approximately Located 28 km north of Dawson Creek off Highway 97 (Alaska Highway) on the Old Alaska Highway.
- B. The Park is a Class A park established under the *Park Act* in 1962.
- C. Section 17 of the *Park Act* states:

A Director or any Park Officer acting on the Director's behalf may do one or more of the following:

- (c) Order any person in any park, conservancy or recreation area to cease or refrain from an action, an omission or conduct that the Director or Park Officer, in his or her discretion, considers dangerous to life or property or detrimental to the public interest.

ACCORDINGLY, the Regional Director orders:

1. The closure of Kiskatinaw Provincial Park to all recreational users dated 2021-06-18 is hereby rescinded. This rescission is effective immediately.
