

Notice:

Beach Advisory issued for Alice Lake

Issued By: Vancouver Coastal Health

This advisory is being issued due to a suspected bloom of cyanobacteria (blue green algae) detected in the lake. Lab testing is underway to confirm.

Exposure to toxins produced by cyanobacteria may cause nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or fever in humans and pets.

Other symptoms from contact with contaminated water include skin rashes and irritation of the ears and eyes.

People and pets should not swim in water until further notice.

Anyone who comes into contact with a cyanobacterial bloom should rinse off with a source of clean, uncontaminated water immediately after exposure.

Alice Lake Provincial Park's drinking water system is serviced by wells which are not impacted by this notice.
