



BEAR CREEK Canyon Trail

Welcome to the Bear Creek Nature Trail

The Loop Trail section offers a short 15 minute walk. The Canyon Rim trail approximately 2.5 kilometres long with an elevation gain of 90 metres. The average time to complete this trail is about 2 hours. A shorter distance can be hiked by using the Mid-Canyon cut off.

Caution:

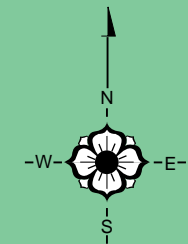
Dangerous cliffs and drop offs. Short-cuts and trail braiding cause erosion. Please be responsible and stay on the trail.
