

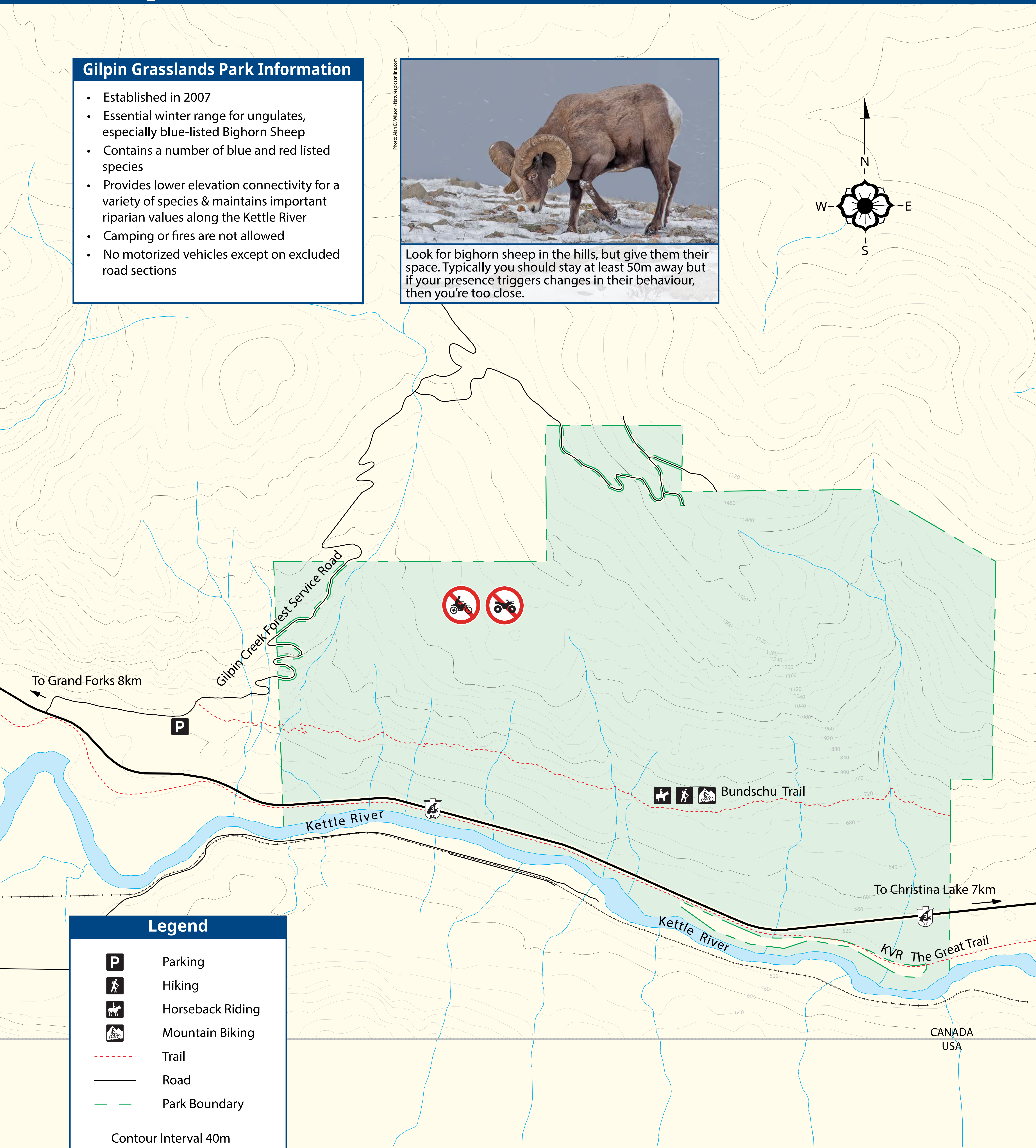
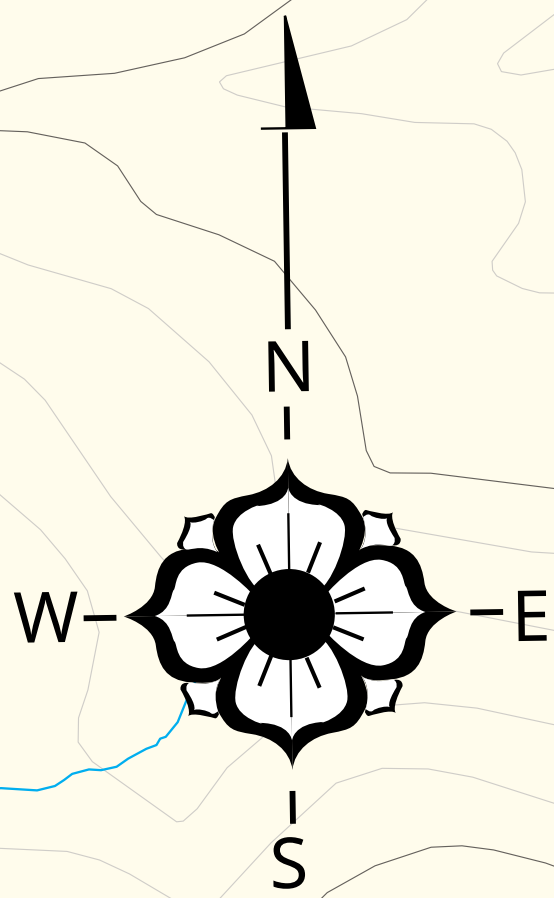
# Gilpin Grasslands Provincial Park

## Gilpin Grasslands Park Information

- Established in 2007
- Essential winter range for ungulates, especially blue-listed Bighorn Sheep
- Contains a number of blue and red listed species
- Provides lower elevation connectivity for a variety of species & maintains important riparian values along the Kettle River
- Camping or fires are not allowed
- No motorized vehicles except on excluded road sections



Look for bighorn sheep in the hills, but give them their space. Typically you should stay at least 50m away but if your presence triggers changes in their behaviour, then you're too close.
