

Welcome to the Park

Only 20 minutes from Victoria, Goldstream Provincial Park offers spectacular hikes past ancient, massive trees and majestic waterfalls. The Freeman King Visitor Centre provides innovative interpretive displays and programs year-round. Visit in the autumn to see the famous annual salmon run and the bald eagles that take advantage of the bounty.

Things to Do



The park has a large day-use area.



Trails range from easy walks to strenuous hikes. More adventurous hikers can climb to the top of one of the highest points in Greater Victoria — Mt Finlayson.



There are some sections of the Goldstream River near the campground that may be used for swimming.



Riverside trails and observation platforms provide views of the fall salmon run and the feeding frenzy of bald eagles. The best time for viewing is late October to November. Other points of interest include old-growth Douglas firs more than 600 years old and the stunning Niagara Falls.



Park naturalists are at the Goldstream Nature House/Freeman King Visitor Centre and offer interpretive programs and lectures about the area's natural history.



A brand new adventure playground is open for park visitors.

Enjoy Your Stay

Park regulations protect the natural state of the park and ensure a quality experience for all visitors.

- Fires are permitted in designated fire rings only. Visitors may bring firewood or purchase at park.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times. Please be responsible for their behaviour and waste.
- Put food in vehicle at night to avoid bear problems.
- Quiet hours are 10 pm to 7 am.


