




Graystokes

The road through the park is not maintained. It may or may not be suitable for high clearance four-wheel drive vehicles.

Graystokes became a Provincial Park in 2001, the primary management values are for water, conservation/biodiversity and recreation. The map identifies vehicle access routes with side trails marked as No Vehicles Beyond This Point.
