

# Leighton Lake Trail

## Leighton Lake Trails

Tunkwa Provincial Park protects grasslands, wetlands and forest ecosystems and these trails are a great way to see them.

Osprey are a common site at Leighton Lake—you may see one pluck an unlucky trout from the water.

Take a side trip to Bluff Hill which provides great views out over Tunkwa Lake. Bluff Lake, with its associated marshes, is the perfect place to see waterfowl and other birds.

Wear a hat and plenty of sunscreen—significant portions of the trails are through open areas.



### LAKE LOOP CIRCUIT – 4.3 KM

(includes distances through campgrounds)

- **Tunkwa Campground to Leighton Campground** – 900 meters
- **Leighton Campground to North Leighton Campground** – 300 meters
- **North Leighton Campground to Tunkwa Campground** (around north and west sides of lake) – 2100 meters

### BLUFF TRAIL TO BLUFF HILL – 1200 M
