

Welcome to the Park

Set on the shore of Nicola Lake, Monck Provincial Park offers a wide assortment of recreational activities. A very popular family-oriented campground in a hot, dry setting, this park is very busy during the summer season. In addition to providing recreational opportunities, Monck protects a ponderosa pine, bunchgrass ecosystem and a volcanic rock cliff landscape.

Things to Do



A 5 km self-guided interpretive hiking trail loops around the park and is best started from the upper end.



There are 40 picnic tables; 15 tables are sheltered.



There is a sandy beach with buoys sectioning off the swimming area. The beach shelves quickly to deep water — swimmers need to use caution.



Canoeing, waterskiing and kayaking opportunities are available; however, extreme caution should be used due to the frequent high winds on the lake. These boats should stay close to shore.



There are 26 fish species in the lake. An appropriate fishing licence is required.



Frequent high winds on the lake make for great windsurfing.



Excellent bird-watching spring and fall. There are deer and bear sightings in the fall.



Visitor Services



During the collecting season a sani-station/dump is available and a \$5 fee is charged for the service.



Monck provides 132 vehicle-accessible campsites, including 16 double sites.



There are potable water posts located throughout the campground.



Two flush toilet buildings have wheelchair accessible stalls.

Enjoy Your Stay

Park regulations protect the natural state of the park and ensure the quality experience for all visitors.

- Campfires are permitted in designated fire rings only. Visitors may bring firewood or purchase at park.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times and are permitted in day-use and beach areas specified for pets. Please be responsible for their behaviour and waste.
- Put food in vehicle at night to avoid bear problems.
- Generator use hours are 9 am - 11 am and 6 pm - 8 pm.
- Quiet hours are 10 pm to 7 am.
- Please keep the animals safe and don't feed the wildlife.

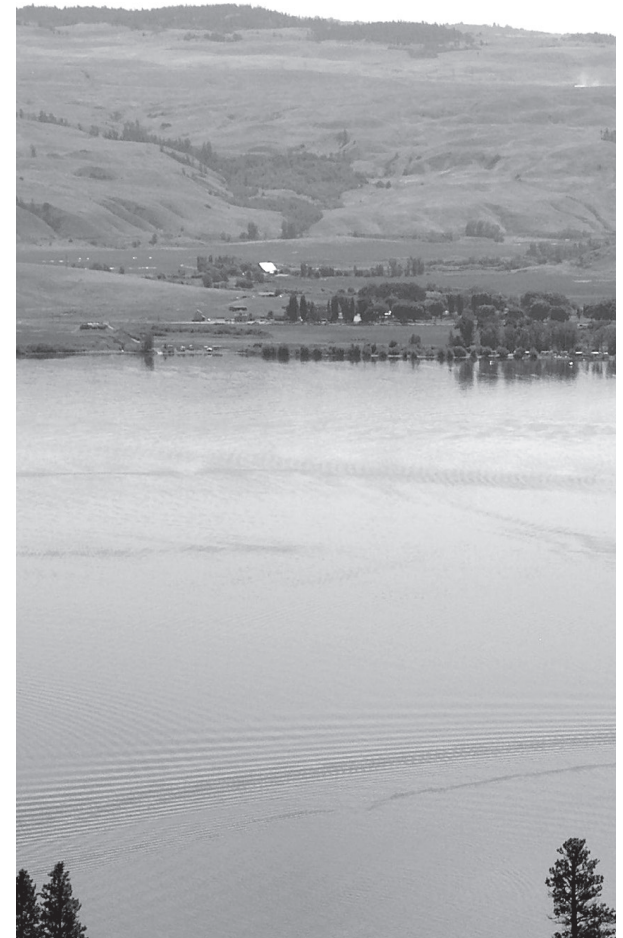

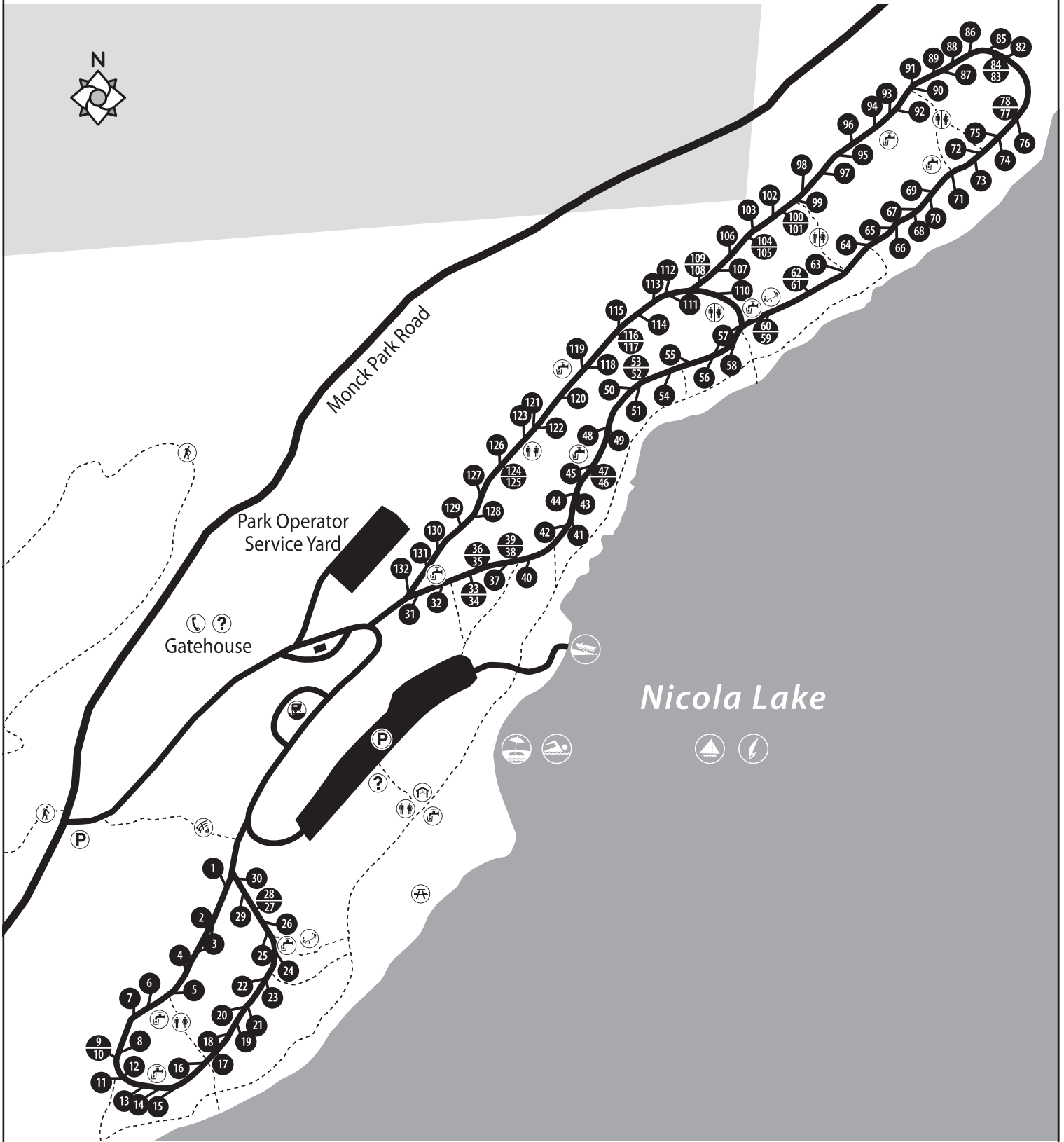
