ROSEBERY PROVINCIAL PARK Purpose Statement and Zoning Plan

Primary Role

The **primary** role of Rosebery Provincial Park is to maintain holiday destination and tourism travel route recreational opportunities oriented to a forested creek setting.

The park is one of two provincial parks that provide camping opportunities to the Slocan Valley. While Rosebery Provincial Park is very small and is mainly used for overnight accommodation, it is strategically located within easy access to Valhalla Provincial Park and Goat Range Provincial Park. The community of New Denver is also nearby and has some attractions for tourists. Rosebery Provincial Park supports this local destination by providing a quality easy access camping experience.

Objective: To provide for a variety of readily accessible, facility-oriented outdoor recreation opportunities.


Natural Environment (approximately 20 ha or 62% of the park)

Objectives: To protect scenic values and to provide for recreation opportunities in a largely undisturbed natural environment.

Conservation Representation - ecosection CCM (Central Columbia Mountains) ecosection is well represented 18.6% in the protected area system. Roseberry contributes minimally .007% (21 ha). The ICHdw has 4.09% protection in the - biogeoclimatic subzone/variant protected area system with Rosebery contributing a minimal 0.132%. 
Zoning Map - Rosebery Provincial Park
