CLOSURES FOR CLIMBING ROUTES



NESTING PEREGRINE FALCONS

Further observations require additional closures to protect the Peregrine Falcon nest. To protect the falcons and park visitors, the climbing routes **Europa, Millenium Falcon, The Façade, The Gauntlet, Sticky fingers, Supernaught, Sunset Strip, Planet Caravan, Warriors of the Wasteland, Gin and Juice, Freeway (including all variations to Freeway), Stone Free, Express Lane, The Parallax View, Fifty-foot Quiche and High Octane** are **CLOSED** to climbing. The cliff at the top of Planet Caravan must not be used for BASE jumping. BC Parks will continue to monitor the nest site and will lift the closure when the nest is no longer in use.
