

Strathcona Trail and Area Conditions – June 5, 2026

Snow is continuing to melt from higher elevations and areas are becoming free of snow. Hikers can generally expect to find snow conditions above 1250 - 1350m while snow may remain at lower elevations in shaded forested areas, and in north facing slopes and valleys. Extreme caution is needed in travelling in snow covered areas at this time while conditions are difficult and snow equipment may still be required to traverse some areas of the park.

Helen Mackenzie/ Battleship Loop, Helen Mackenzie to Kwai Lake via Croteau Lake, Cruickshank Canyon Lookout	All of these areas are snow free. Hikers can expect to encounter snow on trails beyond Croteau Lake. Tent pads are free of snow and all facilities (including food caches and pit toilets are accessible). Croteau Lake Group Site will be available for reservations starting June 26.	June 5, 2026

<p>Helen Mackenzie to Circler Lk, Amphitheatre Lake, Moat Lake, Mount Albert Edward</p>	<p>Moat Lake / Castlecrag Route No camping at Moat Lake. This location is inside the Core Area of the park, and the nearest campsites are at Circler Lake. The Castlecrag route is not maintained and still snow covered at higher elevations.</p> <p>Mt. Albert Edward Hiking Route Most of the route about Circler Lake remains snow covered and route finding skills are necessary. Skis or snowshoes may be necessary. Extreme caution is required in variable and changing conditions. Weather and conditions can change rapidly on this high elevation route.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Weather conditions and visibility can change rapidly. Elk River Trail	Trail is snow free of snow to Landslide Lake. Trail has been cleared of windfall. Camp 1 and camp 2 facilities are open and accessible.	June 5, 2026
Crest Mountain	Winter conditions exist above 1300m of elevation, including at the Lake. Snow is melting quickly in some areas. Bridges may be slippery, please use caution when crossing streams. Winter windfall has been cleared to the treeline.	June 5, 2026
King's Peak	Winter conditions exist above 1300m of elevation with persistent snow are higher elevations. Windfall has been cleared to 1000m.	June 5, 2026
Bedwell Lakes	Winter conditions exist above 1300m of elevation. Baby Bedwell and Main Bedwell camping areas are snow free and facilities are accessible. Some sections of trail remain under snow and snow persists in valleys. Challenging and Marginal hiking conditions exist at higher elevations.	June 5, 2026
Cream Lake	Bedwell – Cream Lake Trail partially under snow at higher elevations.	June 5, 2026
Upper Myra Falls	Trail is free from snow. Windfall has been cleared. Use caution on viewing platform where fallen tree has damaged the railings. Repairs will be underway soon.	June 5, 2026
Arnica Lake/Phillips Ridge	Winter windfall has not been cleared and hikers can expect blowdown throughout and snow at higher elevations. *hikers are reminded to follow switchbacks and not short cut trails. Significant erosion is damaging trail surfaces.	June 5, 2026
Tennent Lake/Mount Myra	Winter conditions exist above 1300m of elevation. Winter windfall has not been cleared.	June 5, 2026
Flower Ridge	Winter windfall has been cleared and trail is mostly snow free.	June 5, 2026
Marble Meadows	Winter conditions exist above 1300m of elevation. Trail has not been assessed this season and hikers can expect blowdown. *hikers are reminded to follow switchbacks and not short cut trails. Significant erosion is damaging trail surfaces.	May 14, 2026

Della Falls & Love Lake Trail	<p>Trail has been cleared of windfall. All facilities at Sawblade Camp and Margaret Creek Camp are accessible. Love lake trail is mostly snow free with patchy snow at higher elevations.</p> <p>No fires are permitted in campsites along Della Falls Trail.</p> <p>NOTE: This is an old growth forest with natural hazards. Campers/hikers should be exercising conservative decision making during stormy weather conditions.</p>	June 5, 2026
Oshinow Lake	Not inspected.	June 5, 2026
Kunlin/Donner Lakes	Travel by vehicle is not possible to Donner Lake. Road to Kunlin Lake is becoming overgrown – watch for deep water bars and small road failures. The trail to Ucona Falls has been cleared of brush by volunteers in 2025. This trail is snow free.	June 5, 2026
Gold Lake	Forest service road (outside park boundaries) bridge decommissioning has made trailhead access impossible by 4x4 truck. This route requires good navigation and route finding ability. Large tree blowdown exists in first 2Km. Exercise caution crossing Gold River.	June 5, 2026
Comox Glacier/ Century Sam Lake	<p>Trail has not been inspected, snow and windfall may be present.</p> <p>NOTE: Be advised that hours for the Comox Main gate access can be found on Mosaic Forest Management website.</p>	June 5, 2026
Mount Beecher, Forbidden Plateau Traverse	Trail is mostly snow free. Winter windfall has not been cleared.	June 5, 2026
