Birch Bluffs	OPEN	Sep-21	3.9 km	Hemp Creek and Trout Creek Bridges washout, so it is not connected to Flatiron or Green Mountain.
Hemp Creek Trail	*OPEN* (bridge washed out)	16-Jul-20	3.0 km	Both horse bridges on Trout and Hemp Creeks washed out, so be prepared to return via Green Mountain or Whitehorse Bluffs.
Birch Bluffs Connector	OPEN	Sep-21	~1 km	This connects Moul Falls and the Birch Bluffs trail
Clearwater River Trail (North)	OPEN	22-Oct-19	6 km	From Hemp Creek campsite to Whitehorse Bluffs campsite. Trail is quite brushy and sections can be flooded during high waters.
Green Mountain Trail	OPEN	Oct-21	5.7 km	This is the former West Tote Rd. and ends at a viewpoint on Green Mountain.
Top of Green Mountain to Hoodoo Trail Connector	OPEN	Oct-21		The area is quite open and a trail is hard to follow at places. Better to hike from Green Mountain down and return via Whitehorse Bluffs for a bigger loop. Two backcountry campsites available on this loop.
